Families must be residents of Tippecanoe or the surrounding counties and must pass a criminal background check. The program has the capacity for up to five families at one time and families can stay for no more than 45 days. Adults are given assistance with job searching, career building, and case management to help obtain stable housing. Family Promise also now operates a prevention program.
